Q: Who can attend SL4K Camp?

A: Any child currently in the 3rd - 6th grade. (school year 2023-2024)

Q: Where is SL4K Camp?

A: Talladega, AL (Shocco Springs Conference Center)

Q: What is the payment schedule for SL4K Camp?

A: (**\$100 non-refundable deposit is due by 3/29/24**). Then, you can make installments: (**\$100-Apr 28**) + (**\$100-May 26**) (or pay in a lump sum). Pay on line at foothills.cc/kidscamp. If paying by check, make checks payable to FC. Include "Kid's Camp" and child's name on the memo portion of your check. Either mail the check to FC P.O. Box 1085 Seneca, SC 29679 or bring it to KidZone on a Sunday morning. **The total cost is \$300 per camper. Additional campers from the same household pay \$275 each for camp.**

Q: Are there any other costs?

A: Yes. \$10 covers lunch on the way home from camp on July 19. (Optional: \$ for souvenirs AND some free time activities.)

Q: What about meals?

A: Pack a picnic lunch for July 16 to eat on the way to camp. All meals at camp are included in the camp price. Feel free to pack snacks as they are allowed to have snacks in their room. **Lunch for July 19 is not included.** Please see above question regarding costs.

Q: What activities are available during free time?

A: Basketball, Tennis, Paddleboats, Four Square, Hang with the band, the actors, or the Techies, Creative Art, Ping Pong, and Gaga Ball, Volleyball, Paddleboards, and more. (**Snack Bar, water slide, aqua park—additional fees required**)

Q: What is the theme this year at SL4K Camp?

A: VOYAGE - God has a grand adventure in store for each of us. We were lost and separated from God because of our sin. But through Jesus, God made it so that there was always a way back to Him. At Student Life Kids Camp 2024, we will set sail to discover what it means to be lost and what it means to be found. What TO bring

- Picnic lunch (**TUESDAY ONLY**)
